

## Configuring Thunderbird v2.0.0.0 (20070326) for Commander 360 email

1. Open Thunderbird and select **Create a new account**
2. Select **Email Account** and click **Next**
3. Fill in your **Name** and **Email address** then click **Next**
4. **Incoming Server** - Must be **POP** server address **pops.onestream.com.au** then click **Next**
5. **Incoming User Name** - Your Commander 360 email address then click **Next**
6. **Account Name** - Your full name or business name then click **Next**
7. You will get a **summary**, check your information, and if everything is **OK** click **Finish**
8. Select your email address and click **Get mail**
9. Provide your **email account password** and click **OK** (select Thunderbird to remember the password)
10. Go to **Tools -> Account Settings -> Server Settings**
11. At the top of the page change the POP Server **Port value** to **995**
12. Under **Server Settings** select **SSL** and tick the box next to **Use secure authentication**
13. In the left hand list click on **Outgoing Server (SMTP)**
14. Select the **server** and **press the Edit** button
15. Under **Settings** change server name to **smtps.onestream.com.au** and the **Port value** to **465**
16. Under **Security and Authentication** select **SSL** then click **OK**
17. Click **OK**
18. Click **Get mail** to test your settings
